Joan Wark	<p><u>New Build Bellfield Primary School</u></p> <p>A query was raised regarding the siting of the new primary School.</p>	<p>It was reported and noted that the consultation exercise for the Council's proposals to build a new primary School for Bellfield/Shortlees had just concluded and that the results of this consultation exercise would be reported to a special meeting of the Education Committee on 12 February 2003.</p>
Peggy Shaw	<p><u>Leisure Provision</u></p> <p>A query was raised regarding the installation of play park equipment at Knowehead as Mrs Shaw advised that she understood that a teenage wall was to have been installed in this location. Notwithstanding, she confirmed that she was happy with the equipment which had been installed at Knowehead.</p>	<p>Councillor Darnbrough confirmed that the Local Committee had put forward a proposal for a teenage wall in the Kilmarnock South Area. Following the Local Committee the Administrative Officer contacted the Head of Leisure to confirm whether or not this suggestion had been included in the proposals for play park provision within the Kilmarnock South Area. A response from the Outdoor Amenities Manager stated that, following consultation, the Community Services Committee, at their Meeting of 13 November 2002, a decision was taken to provide a Toddler and Junior Park at Knowehead. In addition, he also advised that it was intended that a multi sports area under the Better Neighborhood Scheme and that the sports area be provided for five-a-side football and basketball nets.</p>
