EAST AYRSHIRE CHILDREN'S' PANEL ADVISORY COMMITTEE - 30TH ANNIVERSARY OF CHILDREN'S HEARINGS SYSTEM IN SCOTLAND

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** The purpose of the report is to request that the Sub-Committee consider an application from East Ayrshire Children's Panel Advisory Committee (CPAC) to provide a small evening reception hosted by East Ayrshire Council in recognition of the 30th Anniversary of the Children's Hearing System in Scotland.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1** East Ayrshire Children's Panel Advisory Committee are requesting that East Ayrshire Council host a small evening reception in the form of a finger buffet, to mark the 30th Anniversary. The reception will take place on 3 April 2001 in the Pillared Hall, Kilmarnock, between 7.00 p.m. and 9.00 p.m.
- 2.2** The reception will be attended by approximately 60 people which will include members of the Children's Panel, Children's Panel Advisory Committee, representatives of the Children's Reporter Administration and Officer/Elected Member Representation from East Ayrshire Council, as appropriate.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1** This is the first application from the Advisory Committee for civic hospitality. The total cost of the reception is approximately £250.
