INTER AUTHORITY BOWLING MATCHES

Report by Director of Community Services

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To seek approval for funding for two inter-authority bowling matches.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 In 1997, East Ayrshire Council and South Lanarkshire Council established an inter-authority bowling competition. Both Elected Members and employees from the two authorities formed the teams and the competition has been held on an annual basis.
- 2.2 Similarly, there has been a long tradition of inter-authority bowling matches between the three Ayrshire authorities and again the competition takes place on an annual basis.
- 2.3 It is the turn of East Ayrshire to host both of these events in 2001, and it is proposed that the Ayrshire competition will be held in May/June and the South Lanarkshire match in August.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The total estimated cost of hosting both tournaments is £2,000 in 2001/2002, nil in 2002/2003, and £1300 in 2003/2004.

4. LEGAL/POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 Nil.

5. CONCLUSION

- 5.1 The bowling tournaments provide an excellent opportunity to build links with the other local authorities in an informal setting.

6. RECOMMENDATION

6.1 It is recommended that:-

- (i) approval is granted to host the above events at an estimated cost of £2,000;
- (ii) the Director of Community Services is requested to organise the events; and
- (iii) the Committee otherwise note the report.
