UNDER 18 SCHOOLS CENTENARY SHIELD MATCH SCOTLAND V ENGLAND

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to request that the Sub-Committee consider an application from the Ayrshire Schools Football Association to provide a pre-match reception in the Park Suite, Kilmarnock, on 30 March 2001.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Ayrshire Schools Football Association have been asked by the Scottish Schools Football Association to host the Scotland v England Under 18 Centenary Shield Match.
- 2.2 The match will kick off at 7.00 p.m. at Rugby Park, Kilmarnock, on Friday 30 March 2001. Thereafter, the Ayrshire Schools Football Association have requested that the Council fund a post-match reception to be held in the Park Suite, Kilmarnock.
- 2.3 There will be approximately 75 people attending the reception, which will consist of a finger buffet with tea/coffee and soft drinks, and will be attended by both teams and officials, referees, members from Scottish and Ayrshire Schools Football Association, representative from Kilmarnock Football Club, Match and Ball Sponsors and Provost Boyd.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 This is the first application from Ayrshire Schools Football Association for civic hospitality. The total cost of the buffet is £296 (75 x £4). The Park Suite have advised that they will not charge for the hire of the hall.

4. POLICY/LEGAL IMPLICATIONS - Nil.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 5.1 To consider the request from the Ayrshire Schools Football Association for a post-match reception.
- 5.2 In the event the request is granted:-
- (i) to consider Council representation at the event; and

- (ii) to remit the necessary arrangements to the Director of Corporate Resources in consultation with the Chair.
