**KILMARNOCK CRICKET CLUB**

**Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources**

**1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to request that the Sub-Committee consider an application from Kilmarnock Cricket Club for a contribution towards the cost of hosting the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Dinner - 12 April 2002.

**2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 Kilmarnock Cricket Club was formed in 1852 and is one of the oldest (third oldest) cricket clubs in Scotland. Despite the problems of having no home ground in recent seasons, the Club continue to run two senior teams and have recently revitalised the junior section, running teams at under 13 and under 15 age.
- 2.2 The Club booked the Grand Hall for the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Dinner on Friday 12 April 2002.
- 2.3 The Club hopes to achieve attendance of 200 to 250 people, including representation from the Scottish Cricket Union, West District Cricket Union, other league clubs, current and former players and other sports clubs in Kilmarnock.

**3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

- 3.1 This is the first application from Kilmarnock Cricket Club for civic hospitality. The total cost of the event is between £2,000 and £3,000 which will include hall hire, catering, speakers, licence and other costs.
- 3.2 The club has requested a contribution of £375.

**4. POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

- 4.1 Council Policy for dealing with applications for recognition of anniversary celebrations of local groups, establishments etc. recommends £3 x 100 plus £1.50 x 50 = £375 for 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
