GLENFIELD BOWLING CLUB, KILMARNOCK

Report by Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to request that the Sub-Committee consider an application from Glenfield Bowling Club, Queen's Drive, Kilmarnock for a contribution towards their 75th Anniversary celebrations to take place on 12 April 2003.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The group are a local Bowling Club and have blind, disabled and youth coaching. They play all clubs in the area in friendly games and host cup games and district finals.
- 2.2 The group intend to celebrate their 75th Anniversary on 12 April 2003 which is the opening day of the bowling season. The event will be attended by approximately 80 people comprising representatives from all local clubs, Scottish bowling, Ayrshire bowling and Kilmarnock bowling representatives plus sponsors who have helped the club over the years.
- 2.3 The club intend to provide a three course lunch with tea, coffee and hospitality drinks for guests.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 This is the first request from Glenfield Bowling Club for funding and the Club has estimated the total cost of the event to be approximately £1,200.
- 3.2 The club has requested a contribution of £500.

4. POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 The Council policy for dealing with applications for recognition of Anniversary celebrations of local groups, establishments etc, approved by this Sub-Committee on 31 January 2001, recommends 25th to 100th Anniversaries = £3 per year, so therefore, for a 75th Anniversary the recommended amount would be £3 x 75 = £225.

5. LEGAL IMPLICATIONS - Nil.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS

6.1 The Sub-Committee is asked to:-

- (i) consider the request from Glenfield Bowling Club for a contribution towards the cost of the 75th Anniversary celebrations; and
- (ii) to remit the necessary arrangements to the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources in consultation with the Chair.
