BARSHARE PRIMARY SCHOOL, CUMNOCK

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to request that the Sub-Committee consider an application from Barshare Primary School, Cumnock, for the provision of a trophy to commemorate the 25th Anniversary of the School.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Barshare Primary School, Cumnock, celebrates its 25th Anniversary in June of this year. The School will be marking the occasion with a concert, followed by a cutting of the cake ceremony.
- 2.2 The event will be attended by pupils, parents, former pupils, members of staff and members of the community as well as Elected Members and Officials from the Department of Educational and Social Services.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The school is able to meet the financial costs of the event and are requesting that the Council recognise the occasion by presenting a trophy to the school for presentation annually to the pupil who makes a significant contribution to the school and community. In this way it would be a lasting memory of the occasion.

4. POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 Council policy for dealing with applications for recognition of anniversary celebrations of local groups, establishments etc recommends £3.00 x 25 = £75.00 for a 25th Anniversary. The Policy also allows for consideration of a suitably engraved bowl at a cost of around £100 (dependant upon the length of engraving required) as the appropriate civic gift for such occasions.

5. LEGAL IMPLICATIONS - Nil.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 6.1 The Sub-Committee is asked to:-

- (i) consider the request from Barshare Primary School, Cumnock, for the provision of a trophy to celebrate their 25th Anniversary, up to the value of £75; and
- (ii) remit the necessary arrangements, including Council representation, to the Director of Corporate Resources in consultation with the Chair.
