NEW CUMNOCK GOLF CLUB

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to request that the Sub-Committee consider an application from New Cumnock Golf Club for a contribution towards their centenary celebrations to take place on 2 November 2002.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 New Cumnock Golf Club was established in 1902. The last twenty years has seen the membership grow to over 180 adult members and 45 juniors. Sportsscotland helped with the building of the clubhouse and the Minerals Trust helped with the purchase of cutting equipment.
- 2.2 The Club will host their centenary dance on 2 November 2002 to be held in Lochside House Hotel. The event will be attended by approximately 100 members, 20 sponsors and partners and appropriate Elected Members and MSP's.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 This is the first application from New Cumnock Golf Club for civic hospitality. The total cost of the event is estimated by the Club at £1,800.
- 3.2 The Club has requested a contribution of £400.

4. POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 Council policy for dealing with applications for recognition of anniversary celebrations of local groups, establishments etc., approved by this Sub-Committee on 31 January 2001, recommends 25th - 100th anniversaries = £3.00 per year, so therefore for a centenary anniversary the recommended amount would be £3.00 x 100 = £300.

5. LEGAL IMPLICATIONS - Nil.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS

6.1 The Sub-Committee is asked to:-

- (i) consider the request from New Cumnock Golf Club for a contribution towards the cost of their centenary celebrations; and
- (ii) remit the necessary arrangements to the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources in consultation with the Chair.
