NEWMILNS VESUVIUS AFC

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to advise the Sub-Committee of a contribution of £150 made in terms of the delegated authority of the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources, following consultation with the Chair, to Newmilns Vesuvius AFC towards the cost of hall hire in respect of their event to take place on 17 May 2003.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Newmilns Vesuvius AFC will be participating in its first Scottish Cup Final to take place on Monday 17 May 2003 and are holding an event to take place in the Morton Hall, Newmilns on that evening.
- 2.2 The event will take the form of an informal party.
- 2.3 The request for a contribution was received on 6 May 2003 with the group seeking a contribution of £150. Due to the event taking place on 17 May 2003 and there being no suitable meeting before this date at which the request could have been considered, the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources, in consultation with the Chair, exercised her delegated authority to deal with the application and awarded the group £150.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 This is the first application from Newmilns Vesuvius AFC for Civic Hospitality.
- 3.2 The Club had requested a contribution of £150.

4. POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 Council protocol for determining Council representation at such Civic events was approved by Council on 27 June 2002 and recommends that, where this Sub-Committee does not determine Council representation then the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources, in consultation with the Chair of the Members Services and Civic Ceremonial Sub-Committee and the Provost will determine Council representation.
