ISSUES RAISED DURING THE 15 MINUTE QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

ISSUES RAISED	RESPONSE/ACTION REQUIRED
Mr Jimmy Miller, Named Substitute, Dunlop and Lugton Community Council, requested information on the programme of lane marking on roads, particularly the A735.	Brian Weadon, Roads Area Engineer responded that white lines were inspected on a monthly basis with white line painting generally taking place in the summer months. The A735 is on the list for work to be undertaken. Mr Miller was subsequently contacted personally by a Roads Division official.
Mr Muirhead, Community Representative, Fenwick Community Council raised the issue of lack of post box facilities in the Southcraigs area.	Alex Hewetson, Administrative Officer, reported that the Department of Corporate Resources had written to Royal Mail requesting them to investigate this matter and that it would be reported to the various parties at a later date.
Mr Muirhead then raised the issue of planning policy as it related to conservation areas particularly in relation to the installation of upvc windows in new build or refurbished properties within such areas.	The Chair intimated that she would request the Planning Division to include this issue when they reported on designation of conservation areas to the March meeting of this Committee.
Ian Finlayson, Community Representative, Stewarton and District Community Council, raised the issue of the Dunlop/Stewarton road suffering from water cascading from the overhead railway bridge which may prove treacherous underfoot.	Alex Hewetson, Administrative Officer agreed to include this on the list of issues to be addressed by Strathclyde Passenger Transport at the March meeting of this Committee.
