Mr Charles Lindsay, Community Representative, Tenants/Residents Association circulated photographs showing a number of matters pertaining to perceived problems regarding road signage in the Stewarton Area.	It was agreed that the photographs be passed to Jim Kane, Head of Roads and Transportation for his attention.	Jim Kane, Head of Roads and Transportation responded directly, by letter, to Mr Lindsay on 27 June 2003 (copy attached).
Mr Charles Lindsay, Community Representative, Tenants/Residents Association made reference to the lack of a resident neurologist for the NHS in Ayrshire resulting in lengthy waiting lists for treatment in Glasgow.	It was agreed that the Administrative Officer write to the East Ayrshire Local Health Care co-operative inviting them to attend a future meeting of this Local Committee to give a presentation on their role, provide some background to the level of services available within East Ayrshire, comment on waiting lists and answer any questions the Committee may have.
