AWARDING OF CONTRACT

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide, for information, details of a tender which has been accepted.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Council, at its meeting held on 24 September 1998 (Item 8, Page 3754) agreed the Standing Orders relating to contracts, which apply to all contracts for the supply of goods and materials for the provision of services or for the execution of works. The contract was awarded in terms of these Standing Orders.

3. CONTRACT - SITE INVESTIGATION MEASURED TERM CONTRACT

- 3.1 This is a measured term contract which was awarded on a Schedule of Rates basis for a period of two years from 30 November 2000 with two possible extensions of one year each.

3.4 The tenders were then evaluated on set criteria and following the outcome of the evaluation, the contract was awarded to Omnitech (Scotland) Ltd, Prestwick.
