

EXCERPT FROM HOUSING COMMITTEE OF 7 FEBRUARY 2002

HOUSING REVENUE ACCOUNT 2002/2003: DRAFT ESTIMATES (Item 1, Page , 99/02)

2. There was submitted a joint report (circulated) by the Directors of Homes and Technical Services and of Finance on the outcome of the consultation exercise for the Housing Revenue Account on the Draft Estimates for 2002/2003, as considered by the Special Housing Committee of 16 January 2002, and on the associated possible rent levels for 2002/2003.

Councillor Kelly, seconded by Councillor Macrae moved that the Committee:-

- (i) recommend to the Policy and Resources Committee:
 - (a) approval of the Draft Estimates for the Housing Revenue Account 2002/2003 as submitted to the Special Housing Committee of 16 January 2002;
 - (b) approval for 2002/2003 of a flat-rate increase on all house rents of £1.47 per week over a 48 week period, in order to balance the Housing Revenue Account; and
- (ii) otherwise, to note the terms of the report.

Councillor Reid, seconded by Councillor D Coffey moved as an amendment to note the Draft Estimates for the Housing Revenue Account 2002/2003 as submitted to the Special Housing Committee of 16 January 2002, and the level of rent increase proposed; and to continue these matters for further consideration.

On a division by a show of hands the motion was carried by 10 votes to 6.
