EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

1. SELECTION PANEL FOR THE POST OF HEAD OF ROADS AND TRANSPORTATION

2. There was submitted a report dated 31 May 2000 (circulated) by the Director of Corporate Services which (i) advised of the background to the restricted interviews required for the appointment to the post of Head of Roads and Transportation; (ii) presented information on the three candidates participating in the restricted interview process with a view to making an appointment; and (iii) included the following documentation, namely:-

- (i) synopsis of applicants' experience;
- (ii) Employee's Personal Profile Pro-formas;
- (iii) copy of job outline;
- (iv) copy of person specification;
- (v) copy of Roads and Transportation structure chart; and
- (vi) report prepared by each of the interviewees.

The Sub-Committee then interviewed, in turn, Sandy Gillat, Jim Kane and Alistair Wyper.

After consideration it was agreed:-

- (i) to offer the post of Head of Roads and Transportation to Jim Kane;
- (ii) that all Elected Members of the Council be informed of the appointment; and

- (iii) that the necessary arrangements be remitted to the Director of Corporate Services.

The meeting terminated at 1235 hours.
