CAIRNS NURSERY SCHOOL - 25th ANNIVERSARY

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to request consideration of an application from Cairns Nursery School, Farm Road, Kilmarnock, for civic hospitality in respect of their 25th Anniversary celebrations.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Under normal practice an application of this nature would be submitted to the Members' Services and Civic Ceremonial Sub-Committee for consideration but in this instance the event is due to take place prior to the next meeting.
- 2.2 To celebrate the 25th Anniversary the nursery school are holding an open day combined with the opening of the nursery school's garden project. Invitations are extended to the first 10 children registered in 1975, parents, children and Council guests. The nursery school would like to provide birthday cake, tea/coffee and shortbread. The numbers attending the event are anticipated to be between 150 and 200.
- 2.3 The process as to how the Members' Services and Civic Ceremonial Sub-Committee deal with applications for civic hospitality for anniversaries is under review at present and a report will be submitted to the next meeting of the Members' Services and Civic Ceremonial Sub-Committee to be held on 8 November 2000 for consideration.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The total cost of the event is approximately £140 which can be met from the Civic Ceremonial budget.
