CONSIDERATION OF PLANNING APPLICATION

1. APPLICATION NO 96/0426/FL: MRS A BLYTH

There was submitted a report dated 15 October 1996 (circulated) by the Head of Planning and Building Control which sought determination of a full application for the erection of fences at 19 Luce Avenue, Kilmarnock.

Neither the applicant nor the objector were in attendance.

The Principal Planning Officer reported that two letters of objection had been received, details of which were given; summarised the planning considerations in respect of the application, and gave the recommendation of the Head of Planning and Building Control: Approval subject to the following condition, viz:- (1) the development to which this permission relates must begin within five years from the date of this permission. This condition being imposed to comply with Section 38 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972; and (2) that the gates shall open away from the public road to prevent obstruction. This condition being imposed in the interest of road safety.
