**STREET TRADER'S LICENCE - THOMAS GORMAN, 31 MILLHILL AVENUE,  
KILMAURS**

4. There was submitted a report (circulated) by the Director of Community Services in relation to licensed Street Trader, Mr Thomas Gorman, 31 Millhill Avenue, Kilmaurs.

Having noted that Paragraph 3.3 of the report should begin with the words "the allegations are" and that the Chief Constable had been consulted on the matter, it was agreed:-

- (i) to suspend Street Trader's Licence No. EA/ST106 in terms of Paragraph 11, Schedule 1 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982; and
- (ii) to commence proceedings to consider at the next meeting of the Licensing Sub-Committee, suspension of the same Street Trader's licence in terms of Paragraph 11, Schedule 1 of the Act.
