REPRESENTATION ON OUTSIDE BODIES

1. There was submitted a report dated 4 June 1997 (circulated) by the Director of Development Services recommending consideration of Council representation on a number of outside bodies following Councillor McIntyre's appointment as the Chair of the Development Services Committee.

Having noted that one of the representatives on the Ayrshire and Arran Tourist Board was Councillor John Smith and not Councillor George Smith as stated in the report, it was agreed, as the undernoted bodies were due to meet prior to the Council meeting on 19 June 1997, that on an interim basis until the Council meeting on 19 June 1997, Councillor Turnbull be replaced by the Chair of the Development Services Committee on the following outside bodies:- Ayrshire and Arran Tourist Board, Kilmarnock Town Centre Management Initiative and East Ayrshire Business Partnership.

ADDITIONAL ITEM

2. The Chair agreed that the undernoted item of urgent business be considered under exclusion of Press and public as an early decision was required.
