1. There was submitted the Conferences and Courses Budgetary Update advising that £3,870 remained.

**CONFERENCES/COURSES**

**2.1 A HEALTHIER SCOTLAND - NATIONAL CONFERENCE, GREENOCK - 26 MAY 1998**

There was submitted a report dated 12 May 1998 (circulated) by the Director of Social Work proposing that East Ayrshire Council be represented at the major National Conference in respect of the Green Paper "Working Together for a Healthier Scotland".

It was agreed to authorise attendance at the above Conference by two Members of the Administration and one Member of the Opposition, if available, the names to be notified to the Chief Executive as soon as possible.
