**CHINESE NEW YEAR CELEBRATIONS
REQUEST FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

1. There was submitted a report dated 5 February 1997 (circulated) by the Director of Community Services providing details of a request by the Chinese Community Association, Kuloc, for financial assistance to celebrate the Chinese New Year.

It was noted that the Group sought a grant of £1,000 which was approximately 25% of the total cost of the event and that the cost could be met from the budgets held by the Policy and Resources Committee.

It was agreed to make a grant of £1,000 to Kuloc, subject to the Council's standard conditions for grant.

**ATTENDANCE AT THE ASSOCIATION OF DIRECT LABOUR ORGANISATIONS
(ADLO) CONFERENCES (Item 1.4, Page 1919)**

2. There was submitted a report dated 31 January 1997 (circulated) by the Director of Commercial Operations providing details of Conferences organised by ADLO which might involve Member attendance.

Having noted the contents of the report, it was agreed, viz:-

- (i) that in relation to the Association of Direct Labour Organisations - Northern Region Annual Seminar - 20-22 February 1997, Southport, to authorise attendance by one Member of the Administration, the name to be notified to the Chief Executive as soon as possible; and
- (ii) that in relation to the other Conferences of potential interest referred to within the report that these would be considered on an individual basis by the Members' Services Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee when notification of the Conferences was received by the Council.

The meeting terminated at 1218 hours.
