#### **STREET TRADER'S LICENCE: GARY STEWART, 49 WATSON TERRACE, DRONGAN**

2. There was submitted a report (circulated) by the Director of Community Services in relation to a complaint received from Strathclyde Police with regard to the conduct of a licensed Street Trader, Mr Gary Stewart, 49 Watson Terrace, Drongan and providing details of the complaint.

It was agreed:-

- (i) to suspend, in terms of Paragraph 12 of Schedule 1 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, Street Trader's licence nos S.T. 149 and S.T. 253, held by Mr Gary Stewart, 49 Watson Terrace, Drongan; and
- (ii) that the Director of Community Services commence proceedings to allow consideration at the next meeting of the Licensing Sub-Committee, suspension of the said Street Trader's licences, in terms of Paragraph 11 of Schedule 1 of the abovementioned Act.
