POST OF HEAD OF BUILDING AND WORKS - INTERVIEW (Item 2, Page 4395)

2. There was submitted a report dated 19 February 1999 (circulated) by the Director of Personnel Services confirming arrangements for a further interview of a candidate for the post of Head of Building and Works. A copy of part B of the applicant's application form was tabled at the meeting.

The Sub-Committee then further interviewed John Stobie.

John Stobie left the meeting to allow the Sub-Committee to deliberate on the appointment.

It was unanimously agreed:-

- (i) to offer the post of Head of Building and Works to John Stobie;
- (ii) that all members of the Council be informed of the appointment; and
- (iii) that the necessary arrangements be remitted to the Director of Personnel Services.

John Stobie was recalled to the meeting and advised of the Sub-Committee's decision and duly accepted the offer of the post of Head of Building and Works.
