CONSIDERATION OF PLANNING APPLICATION

1. APPLICATION NO 96/0220/FL: MRS A CONNOR

There was submitted a report dated 5 September 1996 (circulated) by the Head of Planning and Building Control which sought determination of a full planning application for the erection of a ranch type wooden fence dividing the rear gardens of Nos 114 and 116 Whatriggs Road, Kilmarnock.

The Principal Planning Officer reported that one letter of objection had been received, details of which were given in the report; summarised the planning considerations in respect of the application, and gave the recommendation of the Head of Planning and Building Control: Approval subject to the following condition, viz:-

- (i) the development to which this permission relates must begin within 5 years from the date of this permission. This condition being imposed to comply with Section 38 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972.

It was agreed to grant the application subject to the above condition and the undernoted additional condition:-

- (ii) that the clothes pole between the skins of the fence shall be maintained to the satisfaction of the Planning Authority This condition being imposed in the interests of residential amenity.

The meeting terminated at 1405 hours.
