COMMUNITY GRANTS

LOCAL COMMITTEE COMMUNITY GRANTS SCHEME 2000/2001

1. There was submitted a report dated 27 June 2000 (circulated) by the Director of Corporate Services outlining the financial position in respect of Community Grants for the financial year 2000/2001, together with a summary statement relative to outstanding applications for Community Grant received from local organisations.

In respect of the applications relative to items (e)(i), (f)(i) and (f)(ii) below, the Administrative Officer provided additional background information and informed that assessing officers had recommended approval.

It was agreed as follows:-

- (i) **Applications Approved** (for the purpose stated in the application):-
 - (a) Arts and Cultural
 - (i) Dalmellington Booktown Initiative - £250
 - (b) Community Councils
 - (i) Dalrymple Community Council: Summer Seats (supplementary) - £192.50; and
 - (ii) Dalmellington Community Council (Hanging Baskets Project) - £300.
 - (c) Leisure Activities
 - (i) Drongan and District Horticultural Society - £300;
 - (d) Older People
 - (i) Bellsbank Street Wardens - £665 (based on an amount of £3.50 per capita of registered membership, the Group having a total registered membership of 190).
 - (e) Women's Issues
 - (i) The Happy Hens, Drongan - £450.

(f) Young People

- (i) Bellsbank Adventure Playground Summer Playscheme - £1,050;
and
- (ii) Droangan Summer Playscheme - £500 (subject to the Group's meeting the appropriate registration/inspection requirements).
