There was submitted a report dated 7 August 1996 (circulated) by the Director of Community Services to seek the approval of the Sub-Committee for the increased costs to carry out security arrangements at the Dick Institute, Kilmarnock, in accordance with recommendations made by the Security Advisor of the National Museums of Scotland.
